ROPE RESCUE AWARENESS/OPERATIONS

Description

Rope Rescue Awareness/Operations (RRA/O) is a 40-hour California State Fire Marshal certified course taught in a five-day format. RRA/O also serves as the new prerequisite to Rope Rescue Technician or RRT. This course provides information on low-angle and high-angle rescue, familiarizing participants with operation of simple, complex, and compound rope rescue systems in the low and high-angle environments.

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
